SCHOOL BUS RULES

In order to guarantee your child and other children riding the school bus the safe transportation they deserve, we will use the following bus procedures.

DISTRICT BUS CONDUCT POLICY: (BP 5131.1 and Title 5, Section 14263)

Bus transportation is a privilege extended only to students who display good conduct while preparing to ride, riding or leaving the bus. Parents must ensure that their children understand and obey all bus rules.

Pupils transported in a school bus shall be under the authority of, and responsible directly to the driver of the bus, and the driver shall be held responsible for the orderly conduct of the pupils while they are on the bus or being escorted across a street, highway or road. Continued disorderly conduct or persistent refusal to submit to the authority of the driver shall be sufficient reason for a pupil to be denied transportation.

DISTRICT BUS CONDUCT RULES

- 1. Students must follow the instructions of the bus driver.
- 2. Students are to board and leave the bus only at their specified regular stop unless they can present a note from their parent to the driver indicating another stop. This note must have been cleared through the office in a timely fashion.
- 3. Kindergarten students must be picked up at their designated bus stop by a parent/guardian or the student will be returned to school.
- 4. Students shall not misbehave at bus stops.
- 5. Students are not permitted to enter a bus unless the driver is present.
- 6. Students shall enter and leave the bus in an orderly manner.
- 7. Students shall remain seated while the bus is in motion.
- 8. Students shall sit facing the front of the bus.
- 9. Students are required to share their seats with other students.
- 10. Students may be assigned a seat on the bus.
- 11. Opening and closing of windows will be regulated by the driver. Students shall not put any parts of their bodies outside of a bus window, nor are students to throw anything out of the bus windows or door.
- 12. Students shall not use vulgar or profane language on the bus.
- 13. Students shall not engage in fighting or boisterous conduct, create unnecessary noise or commotion, or shoot or throw things while on the bus.
- 14. Students shall not eat or drink on the bus.
- 15. Students shall not smoke or light matches, lighters or other heat sources on the bus.
- 16. Items which may jeopardize the safety of any person shall not be permitted on the bus.
- 17. No animals shall be transported on a school bus (except guide dogs). Title 5, Section 14252.
- 18. Student must not leave debris of any kind on the bus.
- 19. Large packages or objects may not be allowed on board by the driver.
- 20. Students must not tamper with the bus or bus equipment.
- 21. Students shall not cross a street or highway at the rear of the bus.

7.	Seventh Offense	Loss of bus privilege-year
